<b>Event:</b>	WP2/WP3/WP4 workshop on 'Agricultural production practices in the Spreewald region: which effects do they have on the provision of ecosystem services and how do they get affected by existing governance approaches?'

The workshop organized by the the cp<sup>3</sup> was held at the city hall in Lübbenau with altogether 12 participants. After an introduction round of all workshop participants and a short presentation of the cp<sup>3</sup> project, the remainder of the workshop was structured into three thematic parts. In the first part, the importance of different ecosystem services was discussed from the point of view of the local stakeholders. Also current trends in the provision of ecosystem services – negative and positive – as well as existing synergies and trade-offs between single services very debated. In the second part, the focus of the discussion was on how the provision of these ecosystem services was impacted by specific agricultural production practices, e.g. in regard to associated pesticide treatments, fertilization, tillage, or irrigation measures. It was also discussed which services are needed to sustain certain production practices in the long run. In the third part, a number of existing governance approaches were reviewed and it was disputed how each approach promoted and/or restricted a specific production practice.

The results of the workshop will be used for work packages WP2 (governance models), WP3 (production practices) and WP4 (ecosystem services).
