Background




- Recent trend: increase in collaborative governance in the management of cultural landscapes
- Collaborative governance = cooperation of multiple actors (public/private/civil)
- Reasons for emergence: regulatory, implementation, participatory deficit














Net-Map: aggregated results (NetDraw)





Focus groups: step-by-step






